New player Hockey Registration:

Please note: these directions are only for registering kids who have NOT played organized hockey before.

1. Go to Respect in Sport with Hockey Alberta <https://hockeyalbertaparent.respectgroupinc.com>. Please follow the directions and choose the option that will work best for your family. You will need to complete or provide your current and valid Respect in Sport certificate number and your child's new Hockey ID number (assigned by this site also) to continue with our local TeamSnap registration.
 - a) If you are new to hockey and the Respect in Sport Program with Hockey Alberta, you will need to complete the Respect in Sport program. The program will assign your child a Hockey ID number when you have completed the course.
 - b) If you have a current Respect In Sport certificate, you simply log in to the Respect In Sport site and add your child that is new to hockey. The system then creates the child a Hockey ID number and adds them to your profile.
 - c) If you have an expired Respect In Sport certificate you can still add your child who is new to hockey and re-certify the course for your family.
2. Once you have completed your Respect in Sport certificate with Hockey Alberta, you can go to the Wainwright Minor Hockey website and click on the New Player registration link. This will bring you to our local TeamSnap registration form. Remember...you will need your Respect in Sport certificate number AND your child's new Hockey ID number to complete our registration form. You also will be required to submit a proof of age document (eg: a birth certificate) to complete your registration.
