

# TOWN OF WAINWRIGHT PARKS & RECREATION FACILITY UPDATE

As of February 9th:

- The Restrictions Exemption Program (REP) is no longer in place.
- When entering the facility but not participating in an activity, visitors must continue to wear masks at all times. As of February 14<sup>th</sup> children 12 and under do not need to wear masks in the facilities.
- Capacity Limits remain in place. The PlanWright Financial Arena and Halls must not exceed their current occupancy loads or 500 at a maximum. The Encompass Credit Union Arena must not exceed 50% of its occupancy load (750 people).
- Liquor service must not continue past 11pm and consumption complete by 12:30 am.
- Youth must continue to do self-symptom screening before entering the facility.

As of March 1st:

- Mask use is no longer required within the facility.
- No longer any capacity limits in place. Revert back to occupancy load guidelines.
- Liquor service rules revert back to AGLC guidelines.
- Youth screening no longer required for activities.
- No limits on indoor or outdoor gatherings.

What we recommend:

- Continue to social distance when able.
- Continue to practice safe hygiene like consistent hand washing and sanitizing.
- Continue to wear a mask if you choose to after March 1<sup>st</sup>.

Covid isolation requirements remain the same, please refer to the website below for more information.

All decisions on the lifting of restrictions including details and time frame are based on guidance from the Government of Alberta.
